

Vision Statements PA 1 - 7

Arkansas

Our vision is to provide access to safe, integrated, adequate housing and services, necessary to enable people experiencing chronic homelessness to live with dignity.

It is our mission to ameliorate homelessness and nurture dignity by:

better coordinating existing resources
developing funding options for homeless initiatives
increasing awareness statewide and sharing information among homeless advocates, providers, homeless persons, policy-makers, and the public
collaborating to create new paths and options for people who are homeless\
developing more integrated, adequate, and affordable housing options

Georgia

Homeless persons have increased their independence and been restored to the mainstream of society because state and local resources have ensured optimal opportunities through the creation of an integrated and seamless system of quality services. As a result of these actions, the State of Georgia will have the resources to end chronic homelessness within ten years.

Hawaii

Plan and develop a more comprehensive and integrated system of housing and services for people who are chronically homeless to help them achieve their optimal level of health, safety and well being.

Goal: End homelessness in Hawaii in ten years.

Kansas

To end chronic homelessness in Kansas.

Pennsylvania

We envision a Pennsylvania in which there are no homeless people. Each person will have the support services needed to live as independently as possible in permanent housing of his or her choice. Housing will be accessible, affordable and integrated in the community. The mainstream services will be adequate, well-coordinated and consumer-driven. All housing and services will be offered with dignity and respect.

Rhode Island

We envision a state where no one is homeless. Every person has appropriate housing and adequate income, and receives effective services.
