PURPOSE:

The purpose of the first of two required annual meetings of NACNEP is to discuss the future of nursing practice in the context of interprofessional education and practice while identifying the strengths, challenges, achievable solutions, and replicable models required and/or available to move from discussion to action. This first meeting will include a focus on nursing practice in alignment with the current shifts in the systems of health care.

GOALS:

1. Identify the strengths that align with nursing practices to achieve high quality interprofessional education and practice based care recognizing the shift from the hospital to the community.
2. Describe the challenges faced by nursing practice in preparing for and furthering interprofessional education and practice based care. Consider the influence of the Affordable Care Act, financial reimbursement structures, preparation of the community nurse providers, clear outcomes, etc.
3. Identify the opportunities that could emerge and advance nursing practice.
4. Define existing replicable models and/or promising practices with examples that exemplify interprofessional education and practice based care, care coordination, safety, financial incentives, diversity of the workforce, focus on population health, etc.
5. Develop strategies/recommendations that can be adapted to address the challenges and produce positive outcomes that will advance the leadership and practice of the nurse on the interprofessional education and practice team.
