Dear Manufacturers,

I am writing on behalf of Kings County Hospital Center, 340B ID DSH330202, to inform manufacturers that Kings County Hospital Center recently underwent an audit by the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) of Kings county Hospital Center's compliance with 340B Drug Pricing Program (340B) requirements.

As background, Kings County Hospital Center qualified for the 340B Program as a Disproportionate Share Hospital at 451 Clarkson Avenue, Brooklyn, New York 11203, and has participated in the 340B Program since 1992.

Through the audit process, Kings County Hospital Center was found to have non-compliance within their 340B Program and is responsible for repayment as a result of the following findings:

- 1) Kings County Hospital Center dispensed a 340B drug to an ineligible individual, as prohibited by section 340B(a)(5)(B) of the PHSA.

Kings County Hospital Center reversed the transaction of the one prescription incorrectly deemed 340B-eligible, and removed the prescribing physician from its 340B eligible provider data base.

Kings County Hospital Center has identified all affected manufacturers and has contacted each to notify them of this violation to begin a dialogue on a method for repayment to affected manufacturers. If manufacturers have not received notification from Kings County Hospital Center and believe repayment may be owed for the violation described in this letter, or if you have any questions or comments regarding the violation described in this letter, within the next 90 days from the date of this letter, please contact Mr. Paul A.
