Dear Manufacturers,

On behalf of Municipal Hospital Dr. Rafael Lopez Nussa. ("SJMH") (340B ID# DSH400015), this letter informs manufacturers that SJMH recently completed an audit by the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) in connection with SJMH's participation in the 340B Drug Discount Program (340B Program).

As Background SJMH qualifies for the 340B Program as a hospital that cares for a disproportionate share of low income patients. Located in San Juan, Puerto Rico, SJMH has participated in the 340B Program since October of 2004.

In keeping with SJMH's not-for-profit mission, SJMH maintains an open-door policy, which means it cares for all patients, regardless of their ability to pay. Thousands of people with no or inadequate health care coverage receive free services each year at SJMH. For example, in 2014, SJMH DSH Adjustment Percentage was 28.13% and in 2015 arise to 40.21%.

Through the audit process, SJMH was found to have non-compliance within their 340B Program and responsible for repayment as a result of following findings.

- Finding: SJMH dispensed 340B drugs to ineligible individuals, as prohibited by section 340B (a)(5)(B) of the PHSA.
- Finding: SJMH billed contrary to the 340B Medicaid Exclusion File selection. This may have resulted in duplicate discounts as prohibited by section 340B (a)(5)(A) of the PHSA.

SJMH has identified all affected manufacturers and has contacted each to notify them of these violations to begin a dialogue on a method for repayment to affected manufacturers.
