Dear Tribal Leader:

I am pleased to share that the FY2023 application cycle for the Health Resources and Services Administration's (HRSA's) [Nurse Corps Loan Repayment Program \(Nurse Corps LRP\)](#) is now accepting applications.

- 33 Nurse Corps participants are currently working at tribal sites across the country. In the fiscal year 2022, HRSA made 15 awards to clinicians across different tribal health centers.
- Our nurse participants receive payments totaling 60 percent of their outstanding qualifying nursing school loan balance. In exchange, nurse participants serve full-time at an eligible Critical Shortage Facility (CSF) or as Nurse Faculty employed at an accredited school of nursing for at least two years.
- Those who commit to a third year of service could receive an additional 25 percent of their original loan balance for an optional third year of service.
