Dear Tribal Leader:

I am pleased to share that the 2023 application cycle for the Health Resources and Services Administration's (HRSA's) National Health Service Corps Loan Repayment Program (NHSC LRP) will soon open for application submission. HRSA expects that an additional \$15 million from our annual appropriations of NHSC award funds will once again be dedicated to clinicians serving at Indian Health Service facilities, Tribally-Operated 638 Health Programs, and Urban Indian Health Programs (ITUs).

- For the past three years since HRSA has been able to set aside \$15 million each year for ITUs. Every eligible applicant serving at an ITU has received an NHSC award.
- More than 1,920 NHSC clinicians are currently working at tribal sites across the country. In fiscal year 2022, HRSA made 444 awards to clinicians at 260 tribal health centers.
- HRSA's NHSC program offers licensed primary care providers in eligible disciplines the opportunity to receive loan repayment ranging from \$50,000 to \$100,000.
- In exchange, providers commit to serve full- or half-time at an NHSC-approved site in a designated Health Professional Shortage Area for at least two years.
- The application cycle is for three NHSC loan repayment programs: the <u>National Health Service</u> Corps Loan Repayment Program, the <u>Substance Use Disorder Workforce Loan Repayment Program</u>, and the <u>Rural Community Loan Repayment Program</u>.

I ask that you share this information with the <u>NHSC-approved health care facilities</u> in your communities. Additionally, these facilities can <u>sign up</u> for emails to be notified when the application cycle opens.
