# National Vaccine Plan 2020

- Objective: Update National Vaccine Plan 2010 and National Adult Vaccine Plan 2015
- Outcome: 5-year outlook on immunization of children, adolescents, and adults
- Plan: Analyze stakeholder interviews and public comments, synthesize plan based on 5 goals—1) foster vaccine innovation, 2) improve vaccine safety, 3) increase vaccine confidence, 4) optimize access, 5) promote global immunization
- Timeline: Release in Fall 2020



# National Vaccine Advisory Committee

- Function: Advises ASH (Director, National Vaccine Program) on vaccine development, safety, efficacy, supply
- How: Convenes meetings 3x per year; charged to draft reports on
  - Vaccine confidence
  - Immunization equity
- Timeline: Submit reports to ASH in September 2020



# Healthy People 2030

- Purpose: Provide science-based, 10-year 10 year national objectives for improving the health of Americans (Office of Disease Prevention and Health Promotion, OASH)
- Newly proposed: 2 developmental objectives in immunization
  - Adult immunization composite measure
  - Immunization information system across lifespan
- Timeline: Submitted to HHS Secretary for approval
