Addiction Medicine Fellowship Program

- **Purpose:** To expand the number of fellows at accredited AMF and Addiction Psychiatry Fellowship (APF) programs in underserved, community-based settings. The AMF Program encompasses both psychiatry and an addiction subspecialty for primary care doctors.
- **Goal:** Create a robust community-based clinical training of addiction medicine or addiction psychiatry physicians in underserved, community-based settings who see patients at various access points of care and provide addiction prevention, treatment, and recovery services across healthcare sectors.
