

Congressional Justification for FY 2024



KEY HIGHLIGHTS

- Extend and increase mandatory funding for National Health Service Corps and Teaching Health Center Graduate Medical Education
- Reduce maternal mortality by using Maternity Care Target Areas scores
- Support healthcare needs in rural communities
- Further integrate behavioral health into primary care
- Expand access to treatment for substance use disorder, including opioids




