


## Number of Petitions Filed as of June 1, 2019

  - \$3,848,748,634
- **Activity from October 1, 2018 to April 30, 2019**
  - Excise Tax Revenue: \$122,404,866
  - Interest on Investments: \$47,006,018
  - Total Income: \$169,410,884
  - Interest as a Percentage of Total Income: 28%

# DICP Update

## Significant Activities

- **Implementation of Maternal Immunization Provisions**
  - On April 4, 2018, the [Notice of Proposed Rulemaking](#) (NPRM) to add the category of vaccines recommended for pregnant women to the Vaccine Injury Table was published in the *Federal Register*.
  - Comment period ended on October 1, 2018, and 51 comments were received and are being reviewed.
  - Responses to comments will be included in the Final Rule.
