

## HRSA Operates Under a Continuing Resolution through December 8, 2017

### Purpose

The Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), including HRSA, operates under the “Continuing Appropriations Act, 2018 and Supplemental Appropriations for Disaster Relief Requirements Act” ([Public Law 115-56](#)) signed by President Trump on September 8, 2017. This Act (CR) continues government operations through December 8, 2017.

Continuing with fiscal practices, HRSA will issue non-competing grant awards at a level that is commensurate with the CR funding and guidance. Adjustments to award levels will be dependent on future CRs or after FY 2018 appropriations are enacted. HRSA expects awardees to continue to monitor their expenditures carefully during this period. All legislative mandates that were in effect in FY 2017 remain in effect under this CR, as well as the salary limitation set at Federal Executive Pay Scale Level II of \$187,000, effective January 2017 as per the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2016, Division H, 202, (P.L. 114-113).
