



Grants Policy Bulletin HHS Salary Rate Limit

Purpose

This grants policy bulletin explains that the salary rate limit applies to *all* individuals who work on an award. The 2026 OPM [Salary Table for Level II Executives](#) lists the pay rates that HHS recipients may use for award funding.

Background

Congress sets a yearly limit on how much salary a person can be paid with HHS grant or cooperative agreement funds. Recipients cannot use award funds to pay anyone more than the Executive Level II rate. For 2026, this limit was set in [Executive Order 14132](#) and shown in the Office of Personnel Management's [salary table](#).

On October 1, 2024, HHS updated the [HHS Grants Policy Statement \(GPS\)](#). It states that the salary limit applies to both direct and indirect costs for HHS awards. The salary rate limit applies to all individuals working on the award. This includes staff, contractors, or consultants.

Implementation

- **Awards:** HRSA will not award funding for salaries that exceed the limit. For staff whose salary rates exceed Executive Level II, recipients may pay the excess from non-federal funds.
- **Rebudgeting:** If applicable, recipients may rebudget to reflect the 2026 salary limit, provided adequate funds are available in the existing award. HRSA will not provide supplemental funding to increase salaries.
- **Sub-awards/Subcontracts:** The salary limit applies to sub-awards and subcontracts. Recipients are responsible for monitoring subrecipient and subcontractor compliance.

OFAAM no longer issues an annual Grants Policy Bulletin communicating salary limit changes. Instead, annual updates to the [Salary Cap Table](#) are available on the [Manage Your Grant](#) webpage. Recipients should monitor these resources for updates.
