

HRSA Operates Under a Continuing Resolution through February 8, 2018

Purpose

The Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), including HRSA, operates under the “Extension of Continuing Appropriations Act, 2018” ([H.R. 195](#)) signed by President Trump on January 22, 2018. This Act (CR) continues government operations through February 8, 2018.

Continuing with fiscal practices, HRSA will issue non-competing grant awards at a level that is commensurate with the CR funding and guidance. Adjustments to award levels will be dependent on future CRs or after FY 2018 appropriations are enacted. HRSA expects awardees to continue to monitor their expenditures carefully during this period. All legislative mandates that were in effect in FY 2017 remain in effect under this CR. The salary limitation is set at the Federal Executive Pay Scale Level II of \$189,600, effective January 2018 as per the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2017, (P.L. 115-31).
