

# HRSA Transition to GrantSolutions: Recipient Quick Reference Guide

## What is Happening?

Between now and December 2026, HRSA will be migrating some grants management functionality to [GrantSolutions](#), an existing shared service owned and operated by HHS, that supports the full lifecycle of grants management.

## Why is this Occurring?

The agency's transition to GrantSolutions will help streamline grant management activities by using the platform already used by HHS awarding agencies and aligns with the Department's goal to reduce costs associated with redundant systems. HRSA will join many other HHS awarding agencies that currently use the grants management platform, to include the Administration of Children & Families, Centers for Disease Control, Indian Health Service, Administration for Community Living, and the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.

## When will this Take Effect?

HRSA will migrate active programs to GrantSolutions on a rolling basis. It is expected that all HRSA programs will be in GrantSolutions by December 2026.
