

Advancing Behavioral Health Equity in Rural Communities

The **Rural Communities Opioid Response Program (RCORP)** provides direct funding and technical assistance to rural communities.

We have invested over **\$500 million** since 2018. This funding addresses behavioral health needs, substance use disorder, and opioid use disorder.



Since 2018, we've reached more than **1,800 rural counties**.



In fiscal year 2022, **290 counties** received services from an RCORP-funded provider for the first time.



Investments span across **47 states and 2 territories**.

According to the latest annual data as of August 2021:



RCORP grantees have served more than **2 million rural residents**.



Over **70,000 patients** received medication-assisted treatment (MAT) services.



RCORP grantees supported over **2,600 clinicians** who provided MAT.
