



FY2024:HRSA’s Rural Health Grants

District of Columbia Fact Sheet | November 2024

The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) – through the Federal Office of Rural Health Policy (FORHP) – **provided approximately \$5.1 million in funding to the District of Columbia to increase health care access, strengthen health networks, and provide program evaluations.** FORHP also supports HRSA’s goal to achieve equity for rural Americans by funding efforts to strengthen health care delivery systems, advance maternal health care, reduce the morbidity and mortality associated with substance use disorder, and improve the financial viability of rural hospitals.

By increasing access to quality services and training a more skilled health workforce, these investments from FORHP have allowed communities in the District of Columbia and across the country to improve health outcomes and address health disparities.
