Addressing Substance Use Disorder in Rural Communities

HRSA invested **\$145 million**

in the Rural Communities Opioid Response Program (RCORP) to prevent and treat substance use disorder (SUD) for people in rural areas.



RCORP grantees have hired more than 380 new providers to provide direct SUD prevention, treatment, and/or recovery services.



More than 4 million individuals in more than 1,900 rural counties are served by RCORP grantees.



Over 630,000 individuals have been trained through RCORP to reduce stigma, provide naloxone, and deliver other mental health services to rural patients.



Of the **7,200 HRSA-supported SUD providers, 37%** provide care in rural communities.
