

Addressing Substance Use Disorder in Rural Communities

HRSA invested **\$145 million**
in the Rural Communities Opioid Response Program (RCORP)
to prevent and treat substance use disorder (SUD) for people in rural areas.



RCORP grantees have hired **more than 380 new providers** to provide direct SUD prevention, treatment, and/or recovery services.



More than **4 million individuals** in **more than 1,900 rural counties** are served by RCORP grantees.



Over 630,000 individuals have been trained through RCORP to reduce stigma, provide naloxone, and deliver other mental health services to rural patients.



Of the **7,200 HRSA-supported SUD providers**, **37%** provide care in rural communities.
