

Expanding and Supporting Rural Workforce Development



The Rural Public Health Workforce Training Network Program expanded health care capacity in rural communities by training **1,256 health care providers.**



Through the Rural Residency Planning and Development Program, **38 programs** have achieved accreditation and are projected to create **503 residency positions.**



Through the National Health Service Corps program, HRSA supports **more than 7,400 providers** serving in a rural community, including **nearly 3,100** primary care clinicians, **more than 3,700** mental/behavioral health clinicians, and **more than 600** dental clinicians.



Through Nurse Corps, HRSA supports **more than 800 Nurse Corps participants** serving in rural communities.
