Expanding and Supporting Rural Workforce Development



The Rural Public Health Workforce Training Network Program expanded health care capacity in rural communities by training 1,256 health care providers.



Through the Rural Residency Planning and Development Program, 38 programs have achieved accreditation and are projected to create 503 residency positions.



Through the National Health Service Corps program, HRSA supports more than 7,400 providers serving in a rural community, including **nearly 3,100** primary care clinicians, more than 3,700 mental/behavioral health clinicians, and more than 600 dental clinicians.



Through Nurse Corps, HRSA supports more than 800 Nurse Corps participants serving in rural communities.
