Improving Access to Maternal Health Care



The Healthy Start Program improves health outcomes before, during, and after pregnancy—23 Healthy Start grantees served more than 18,000 participants in rural communities.



Rural Maternity and Obstetrics Management Strategies (RMOMS) Program awardees created maternal health networks to provide prenatal, labor and delivery, and/or postpartum care to **nearly 5,000 rural RMOMS participants**, with **over 3,600 deliveries**.



The Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program reaches **1,013 counties**, of which **60%** are rural.
