

Improving Access to Maternal Health Care



The Healthy Start Program improves health outcomes before, during, and after pregnancy — **23 Healthy Start grantees** served **more than 18,000 participants** in rural communities.



Rural Maternity and Obstetrics Management Strategies (RMOMS) Program awardees created maternal health networks to provide prenatal, labor and delivery, and/or postpartum care to **nearly 5,000 rural RMOMS participants**, with **over 3,600 deliveries**.



The Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program reaches **1,013 counties**, of which **60%** are rural.
