Dear Manufacturers,

I am writing on behalf of Community Action Committee of Pike County (CAC of Pike Co.) 340B ID: CH052900, to inform manufacturers that CAC of Pike Co. recently underwent an audit by the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) of the CAC of Pike Co.'s compliance with 340B Drug Pricing Program requirements.

As background, CAC of Pike Co. qualified for the 340B Program as a Consolidated Health Center, located at 941 Market St., Piketon, OH 45661 and has participated in the 340B Program since January 1, 1992.

Through the audit process, CAC of Pike Co. was found to have non-compliance within the 340B Program and responsible for repayment as a result of the following findings:

1. CAC of Pike Co. dispensed a 340B drug to an ineligible individual, as prohibited by 42 USC 256b (a)(5)(B).
2. CAC of Pike Co. was billing Medicaid contrary to information contained in the HRSA Medicaid Exclusion File. This action may have resulted in duplicate discounts as prohibited by 42 USC 256b (a)(5)(A).

CAC of Pike Co. has identified all potentially affected manufacturers and has contacted each to notify them of these violations and to begin a dialogue on a method for repayment to affected manufacturers.
