Dear Manufacturers,

I am writing on behalf of Walker Baptist Medical Center (WBMC; 340B ID DSH010089) to inform manufacturers that WBMC recently underwent an audit by the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) of WBMC's compliance with 340B Drug Pricing Program (340B Program) requirements.

As background, WBMC qualified for the 340B Program as a Disproportionate Share Hospital located at 3400 Highway 78 East, Jasper, Alabama 35501 and has participated in the 340B Program since April 1, 2005.


Through the audit process, WBMC was found to have non-compliance within their 340B Program and responsible for repayment as a result of the following finding:

Finding #1: WBMC dispensed 340B drugs to ineligible individuals, as prohibited by section 340B(a)(5)(B) of the Public Health Service Act.

WBMC has identified all affected manufacturers and will contact each to notify them of these violations to begin a dialogue on a method for repayment to affected manufacturers. If manufacturers have not received notification from WBMC and believe repayment may be owed for the violations described in this letter, or if you have any questions or comments regarding the violations described in this letter please contact Mr. John Langlois, Chief Financial Officer/Interim Administrator, 205-387-4404, 3400 Highway 78 East, Jasper, Alabama 35501.
